DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY: Next Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday. Jesus told St. Faustina that he desired a special feast in the Church to honor and glorify his great mercy toward mankind. He said: ***“It is my desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter.”*** Hence, the Sunday after Easter is called Divine Mercy Sunday. Jesus made us a great promise: ***“The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.”*** In other words, the one who goes to Confession before Divine Mercy Sunday and thus receives Holy Communion in a state of grace on Divine Mercy Sunday (or on the Saturday evening before) will have all their purgatory time that they have earned to that point wiped away. This is a great grace of which I encourage all of you to take advantage!!!

DIVINE MERCY HOLY HOUR: Next Sunday (Divine Mercy Sunday) there will be a special holy hour of adoration from **2:30pm-3:30pm** with the chaplet of Divine Mercy prayed at **3:00pm at St. Patrick’s**. After the holy hour all will be welcome to **venerate the relic of St. Faustina**.
