MARYTOWN PILGRIMAGE: Fr. David will be leading a pilgrimage to the beautiful shrine of **Marytown** in Libertyville, IL (just north of Chicago) on **September 15-16**. Our group will travel there by charter bus and our accommodations will be at the shrine itself. During our stay we will be able to experience inspiring Masses, as well as, other beautiful devotions led by Fr. David and the Franciscan Friars who live and work at the shrine. In addition to our prayer experiences, our stay will include a tour of the shrine including a tour of the shrine’s St. Maximilian Kolbe exhibit.
